- Power-operated automatic sliding doors, which may be used as emergency egress doors because they “break-out” in the direction of egress;

Other useful features include a custom unobtrusive weather stripping design, which seals out inclement conditions; floating lead edge finger guard; custom finishes and glass, which provide versatile options for any application; designer/utility package, which provides maximum panel weight of up to around 182 kg; access control, which lets users add card readers, electric locks and panic hardware to limit access to restricted areas; access control consoles, which provide four modes of door operation – the timer, manual, one-way and automatic; and electric solenoid locking system, which utilises a high torque stainless steel spring and tension spring.
