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NASA signs deal with Stanley

Brief

WASHINGTON--The National Aeronautics & Space Administration has extended a two-year contract with Stanley Security Solutions to implement access control and security systems throughout the space agency's various facilities in the United States.

The \$4.8 million contract involves an extension of NASA's common badging and access control systems project, under which Stanley will develop and install an external and internal building entry and smart-card based access control and security system.

Initially, five sites will be deployed: Langley Research Center in Hampton, Va.; The Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, Calif.; Glenn Research Center in Cleveland, Ohio; Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Md.; and Ames Research Center in Moffett Field, Calif.

The contract is classified as indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity, and NASA has an option to extend the agreement beyond the two-year period
